- ☉ Please bring appetizers, salad, side or dessert enough to serve 12 to 15 people. Also bring lawn chairs or blankets.

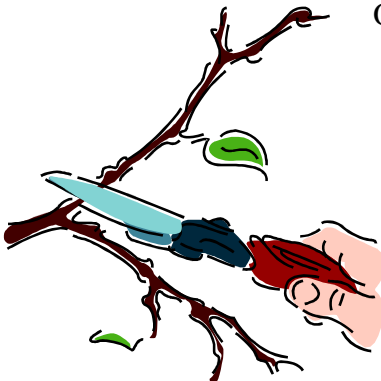
We are looking for volunteers to watch over the moonwalk, help clean up and staff the sign in table.

May Meeting Wrap up

We would like to thank everyone that was able to make it to the May RGNA meeting. Here is an update to the proposed convenience store on Gregory.

Cloud 9 Convenience store, has submitted to Regulated Industries a petition for license to sell Beer and Spirits at a planned store currently occupied by SRO Video. June 2nd was the deadline to turn in affidavits from consenting neighbors that would allow Cloud 9 to open such a store. The proposed owner has requested, and was granted, a 45 day extension, thus pushing the deadline to July 19th. Cloud 9 needs to have 14 of the 27 eligible consenters to agree to the license. At this point, 21 of the 27 consenters have signed an affidavit withdrawing their consent, thus eliminating the chance to get the license. It would be assumed that Cloud 9 has requested the extension with the intent to re-petition the eligible consenters. As updates come forth, they will be posted on RGNA's yahoogroups email service.
